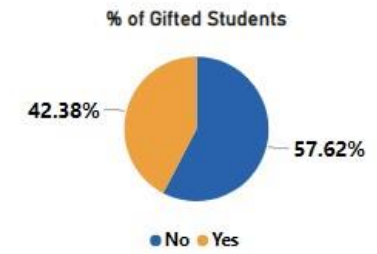
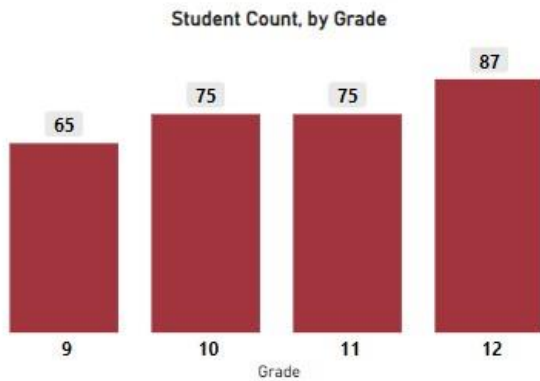

4-Year and 5-year Cohort

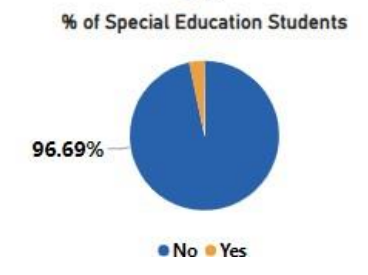
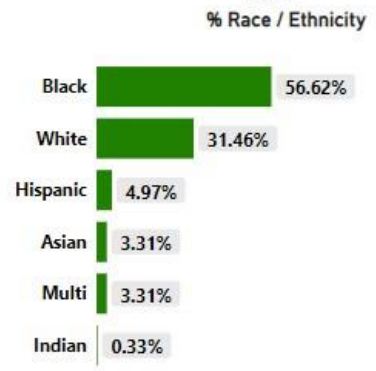
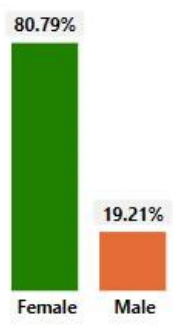
